SOME SAFETY TIPS TO CONSIDER WHEN HIRING A TUTOR

- 1. Check the tutor's profile for student feedback, ratings, and reviews. You can also request references from the tutor.
- 2. If the student is under 18 years old, make sure an adult is present during the tutoring sessions.
- 3. Protect your personal information by not sharing your last name, email address, home address, phone number, place of work, or any other identifying information in initial communication. Don't communicate with anyone who pressures you for personal or financial information or tries to trick you into revealing it. Only exchange personal contact information when you feel comfortable and have payment information on file with the tutoring platform.
- 4. Ensure that the tutoring session is conducted in a private and secure location. Students should avoid using public Wi-Fi networks or shared devices, as these can compromise their privacy and security.
- 5. Goalbi encourages that you should change your password every six months to a year and come up with something that has a mix of letters, numbers and special characters for extra safety.
